## **Mission Statement:**

**The Wisconsin Chapter of ASSE is committed to supporting the Student Section at the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater, as well as the graduates as they transition into their careers.**

**Currently, our chapter supports the students section with open invitations to attend our chapter events, providing speakers to their technical meetings and guest lecture in their courses, and fund/award an annual scholarship.**

**We also recognize the value of providing students pursuing a safety degree with opportunities to network and learn from working professionals, and provide extra-curricular opportunities for students to spend time in workplaces to transition their studies to practice.**

**Therefore, the chapter executive board members strongly support the creation of a mentoring program that matches volunteer professional members with student members. The matching criteria will be the expressed needs and wants from each the mentor and the student.**

## **Timeline Matching and Reporting:**

- 1. Professional member volunteer advertising and registration: Oct 5 – Oct 17**
- 2. Matching students to mentors: Oct 15 – Oct 21**
- 3. Initial contacts between mentors and students: Oct 21 – Oct 28**
- 4. Tentative completion of mentorship agreement: May 31**

## **Expectations:**

- Mentors and students are expect to talk at least once every two weeks**
- Mentors will provide updates on progress to the program chair once per month**
- Mentors are expected to bring/introduce their student to at least one ASSE meeting**
- If logistically possible, mentors are expected to allow the student to shadow them on the job**
