ASSP Wisconsin Chapter Members,

The ASSP Wisconsin Chapter is currently seeking one member who is interested in serving on the board as an elected officer. Chapter officers must be elected by current members of the ASSP Wisconsin chapter in an online E-Ballot election held April 5th, 2023 through April 26th, 2023.
